Duluth--The thirteen member Graduate School General Research Advisory committee of the University of Minnesota will hold its regular meeting on the UMD campus Friday, October 16.

Professor Bryce Crawford, Jr., chairman of the School of Chemistry, University of Minnesota at Minneapolis, is head of the group.

After their regular meeting, individual committeemen will meet with UMD division chairmen, with present recipients of Graduate School research grants and with any UMD faculty member who has a research proposal to make.

At present, eleven Duluth campus faculty members are receiving grants in aid through the Graduate School. Such grants now total more than six thousand dollars.
