# WISCONSIN VS. MINNESOTA

November 25, 1939

Today's Dad's Day game with the University of Wisconsin marks the continuation of the oldest series in midwestern football. It is the 49th meeting between teams representing the Universities of two great neighboring states.

The series was inaugurated back in 1890 when, according to the historians, the Badgers arrived in Minneapolis wearing high silk hats much to the annoyance of the Gophers who won the game 63-0. Since that date the series has continued with a single interruption in 1906 with the Gophers winning 28 games, losing 15, and tying 5.

Like the Gophers, the Wisconsin eleven that will take the field today has been a potentially fine football team all season outgaining its opponents only to end on the short end of the score. Particularly outstanding for the Wisconsin team are said to be halfbacks Bill Schmitz and Bob Cone, and fullback George Paskvan.

Today's game which ends Minnesota's 1939 Conference schedule gives us the happy privilege of welcoming to our Stadium not only the Wisconsin team and loyal Wisconsin fans but also our Minnesota Dads. In the same breath it presents to us the sad duty of saying "Goodbye and Good Luck" to members of the Minnesota squad who have completed their last year of competition for Minnesota. In some future year many of these men will return to be seated near the Minnesota players' bench at some future Dad's Day game. The men who have completed their competition are Phil Belfiori, Martin Christianson, Bronko Danguvich, Orville Freeman, George Gould, Fritz Grewing, Leland Johnson, Sy Johnson, Merle Larson, John Mariucci, Earl Ohlgren, Win Pedersen, and Harold Van Every.

## LOST AND FOUND DEPARTMENT

## PASS-OUT CHECKS

If it becomes necessary for you to leave the Stadium during progress of the game, and you desire to return, be sure that you leave by the Pass-Out Gates which are numbers 3, 8, 16, 22, 28, and 31. Indicate your intention to return to the gatemen and obtain from them a pass-out check. This check will be required in addition to your ticket stub in order to re-enter the Stadium.
