DULUTH-- The Rev. Father John W. Evans, UMD lecturer and Catholic chaplain, is a co-author of a book recently published and is busy as a lecturer.

Father Evans wrote one of the chapters of the book "The Shape of Catholic Higher Education" just published by the University of Chicago Press. The chapter Evans wrote is titled "Catholic Higher Education on the Secular Campus."

He will give five lectures on "The Study of Religion in American Higher Education" next week (June 26-30) at the Newman Chaplains' Training School at Harvard Divinity School.

About 50 priests and nuns preparing to work in Catholic chaplaincies at state universities will attend the school.

Father Evans will talk on "The University and Autonomy" "The University Idea on the American Campus" "Religion on the American Campus from 1850 to the present," "The Newman Chaplain and Religious Education," and "John Henry Newman's Theory of Religious Education."

On Tuesday and Wednesday of this week (June 20-21), Father Evans attended the International Ecumenical Conference sponsored by the Medieval Institute of Western Michigan University. Evans conducted one of the seminars.
