DULUTH--A \$300 scholarship for a UMD student has been established by the St. Louis County Federal Savings and Loan Association, Duluth, Provost Raymond W. Darland announced today.

The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of academic ability, character, citizenship and recommendations from administrators of previous schools attended.

Darland said the student will be given \$100 for each of the three academic quarters. The winner may be either a resident of Minnesota or a non-resident.

The new scholarship will be administered by the UMD Scholarship Committee following approval of recommendations by the Provost and the Secretary-treasurer of St. Louis County Federal Savings and Loan Association.

Applications should be filed at the office of the director of Student Personnel Services at UMD.
