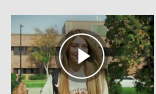

**Fall Camp Notebook: Day 2**

On the second day of practice for Minnesota Crookston football, intern [Hunter Plante](#) sat down with new offensive coordinator [Jared Hottle](#) and quarterback [Reyes Lara, III](#) (R-Fr., QB, Surprise, Ariz.) to talk about the offense and the quarterback group.

**CROOKSTON, Minn.** - There are a lot of new faces in the Minnesota-Crookston football program. One of those new faces include first year offensive coordinator [Jared Hottle](#). Hottle comes from Dakota State (S.D.) where he led a record-breaking offense. Hottle will hope to bring the same type of high powered offense to the Golden Eagles in the fall. Sure, it's only been two days of practice, but coach Hottle likes what he sees from his offense, including his quarterbacks.

"Leadership has been excellent," Hottle said. "Each one of the quarterbacks in the room are students of the game. You can tell them something one time, and they got it."

With every offense, the Quarterback position is key, and that's no different with Hottle's offense. The room for improvement will be important for the Golden Eagles before the season opener August 30th against Minnesota State-Moorhead.

"I think the main thing we need to continue working on is being able to continue to focus, and improving on the fundamentals," Hottle said.

One of the guys in the new look quarterback room is Redshirt Freshman quarterback [Reyes Lara, III](#). Lara, from Surprise, Ariz. likes what he is seeing from the offense as a whole.

"One thing I like is that the offense as a whole, the receivers, running backs, lineman, we're all learning the offense as a whole," said Lara, III. "Coach Hottle is doing a great job this year."

It may be early in fall camp, but the offense looks like it is heading in the right direction under new Offensive Coordinator [Jared Hottle](#).
