UM Reports Update

Work continues in Academic Support Resources (ASR) to move reports off of the UM Reports data platform and onto alternatives (e.g., UM Analytics and PeopleSoft Query).

Deployed: Major/Minor Roster

- The Major/Minor Roster is available in the Reporting Center and is now on the UM Analytics platform.

Deployed: Eligibility for Lower Tuition Fringe Rate Assistantship

- This report is now available for use in the Reporting Center on the PeopleSoft Query platform. It has also moved (effective 11/3/23) from the Human Resources > Work Study dropdown to Student Services > Student Records. This is being done to align the data elements that the report is providing (student groups, etc.) with the appropriate functional area in the Reporting Center.

In-progress: Student Roster Detail and Student Roster Summary Statistics

- Teams in ASR and the Office of Information Technology (OIT) are currently working on building out "academic level" (e.g., sophomore, junior) in the Enterprise Data Warehouse (EDW). Once that is completed it will be added to these reports and will be tested before being deployed. A communication will be sent to users of these reports (i.e., users who have run the reports in the last year) when they are available. We are anticipating that they will be available before the end of the calendar year.

Analysis: Degree Applicants Report

- It has been determined that the Degree Applicants Report will be moved to PeopleSoft Query and teams have been working through a fit/gap analysis and working in collaboration with the system campus registrars to identify which data elements can be replicated in PeopleSoft Query and data elements that will not be carried over into the new report.
- The current UM Report includes two links linking to separate reports – one for student addresses (mailing) and one for student advisors/committees. We are unable to replicate those types of links within the PeopleSoft Query output, but we could include that information in the query itself and it would return as a separate column on the report. The drawbacks are that it would add complexity to the report thus increasing the potential for the report to run long/stall, and including advisor data would mean returning multiple rows for a single student if they have multiple advisors. We are looking for your feedback on how necessary it is to include this information directly in the report. The alternative solution is to create separate queries that would be run for those specific purposes, but that is work that would need to be prioritized and likely would not roll out at the same time as the Degree Applicants report.

Change of College Move to Jadu Update

At the October RAC meeting, we shared information about the Change of College process moving off of the WorkflowGen platform and onto Jadu with some integrations to Perceptive Content. This is an update to the implementation timeline as that has adjusted slightly due to technical work that will now need support from OIT. We are now eyeing a launch to the new process between November 15-30 and will share more exact details as they become available.
