Duluth -- The deadline for receipt of applications for Rhodes Scholarships is October 31, according to UMD Academic Dean Thomas W. Chamberlin.

Elections to Rhodes Scholarships will be held in all states in December. Scholars-elect will enter Oxford University, England in October, 1968.

Application blanks and information may be obtained from Dean Chamberlin's office at UMD, or by writing President Courtney Smith, American Secretary of the Rhodes Scholarships, Swarthmore College, Swarthmore, Pa. 19081.

The stipend of a Rhodes Scholarship is approximately 1150 pounds (approximately \$3,000) per year. Appointment to a Rhodes Scholarship is made for two years with a possible third year if the scholar's record at Oxford and plan of study warrant such an award.

To be eligible a candidate must be an unmarried male citizen of the United States with at least five years' residence. The Scholarship is forfeited by marriage after election or during a scholar's first year of residence.

Other requirements are age 18 to 24, junior or higher standing at a recognized college or university and official endorsement from the college or university.
