Minnesota Crookston Golden Eagle Baseball Games Relocated from Fayette to Crookston Friday and Saturday



CROOKSTON, Minn. – The University of Minnesota Crookston baseball series against Upper Iowa University, originally scheduled to be played in Fayette, Iowa, have been site relocated to Crookston, Minn. The games will be played Fri., April 14 at 1 and 3:30 p.m. and Sat., April 15 at 12 and 2:30 p.m. at UMC Baseball Field. Friday and Saturday's twin-bill was moved to due to a high probability of rain in Northeast Iowa over the weekend.

The series will be an important one for both teams as Minnesota Crookston sits in a tie for 11th place in the conference standings and Upper Iowa is just three places ahead of them as they are in a tie for eighth place. The Golden Eagles have a 15-19 (9-13 NSIC) mark, while Upper Iowa is 13-15 (9-11 NSIC).
