UMC Women's Golf Places Sixth of Eight at Concordia-St. Paul Holiday Inn Invitational



LAKE ELMO, Minn. - The University of Minnesota Crookston women's golf team placed sixth out of eight teams at the Concordia-St. Paul Holiday Inn Invitational Saturday and Sunday at Tartan Park Golf Course in Lake Elmo, Minn. The Golden Eagles were part of a very strong field but put together a strong showing, against besting Minnesota State University Moorhead for the second time this year and defeating University of Sioux Falls for the first time.

The Golden Eagles were led by another strong showing by senior [Katie Sheetz](#) (Grand Rapids, Minn.), who is off to a great start to her final season in the Maroon and Gold. Sheetz has placed in the top 10 in both tournaments this season. She shot an 80 and a 77 to finish tied for seventh this weekend as she put together one of her best weekends of golf in her career.

In addition to Sheetz, [Bailee Hauser](#) (Jr., Raymond, Minn.) shot a 92 and 96 to finish tied for 42nd. [Marina Farrow](#) (So., Arlington, Texas) shot a 94 and 96 to finish 44th, while [Ashlee Humble](#) (So., Rosemount, Minn.) shot great on the first day with an 89 but had a 102 on day two to finish 45th. [McKenzie Harris](#) (Fr., Nevis, Minn.) shot a 100 and 97, while [Rikki Roscoe](#) (So., Big Stone City, S.D.) shot a 104 and 96.

Concordia-St. Paul's Rachel Gray won the tournament with a 72 and 73 to finish one-over-par for the two rounds. She bested Augustana University's Emily Israelson by four strokes. The Vikings of Augustana won the overall tournament.

UMC will head to the Southwest Minnesota State University Invite Sept. 26-27 in Marshall, Minn., as they continue their Fall season.
