DULUTH—One hundred and one letters in eight varsity sports were announced today by UMD Athletic Director Lloyd W. Peterson. The 101 awards to 94 athletes representing 32 different communities points out the growing interest in UMD athletics. Twenty-five Minnesota cities, two Wisconsin and five Canadian are represented. Forty-five of the athletes are Duluthians.

Senior football captain Bruce Johnson headed the list of these given special recognition. Johnson, a senior from Cambridge, is the recipient of the Anderson-Dahle award as the athlete who best combined athletics and scholarship.

The M Club award, voted by the athletes to the outstanding senior letterman went to Ron Johnson, a hockey and golf star. Johnson, a Duluthian, ranks fourth in all-time hockey scoring, and earned Little All-American honors as a golfer.

Speedster Dick LeBeau, the MIAC 100-yard dash champion, was voted the Ed Geberia award as the outstanding track performer. LeBeau is a sophomore from Duluth.

Previously announced awards went to Jerry Wherley, International Falls, as the outstanding football lineman and to Bill Lenardon, Fort William, Ontario as the top hockey player. Wherley receives the Glen Johnson trophy; Lenardon the Marshon Plaque.
