Duluth--- An article by the Rev. John Whitney Evans, Catholic chaplain at UMD, appears in the February issue of the National Catholic Educational Association Bulletin.

Entitled "Catholic Theological Education and the Newman Apostolate," the article discusses the question of the Church's commitment to theological education in higher education.

Father Evans is also a lecturer in secondary education at UMD.

In the article, Father Evans traces the development of theological study in state universities and explores several controversial issues. One of the conclusions he reaches is that "present and future theological investigations of the most significant sort will go on, not within Catholic schools, but in secular institutions."
