Duluth --- Five UMD faculty members have single-quarter leaves for the 1964-65 academic year, Provost Raymond W. Darland announced today following approval by the University's Board of Regents.

The faculty members and the research projects they will pursue on leave are:

Dr. John B. Carlson, associate professor of biology, will be gone fall quarter, 1964 to study "Effects of Gamma-irradiation upon the Floral Development and Embryogeny of Glycine (Soybean)."

Dr. Joseph E. Duncan, associate professor English, will be on leave spring quarter, 1965. He will study "Paradise Lost in Relation to Changing Conceptions of the Earthly Paradise."

Dr. Orazio Fumagalli, associate professor art, will be on leave fall quarter, 1964. His research will involve "A Study of Contemporary Art and Its Milieu."

Dr. Robert C. Hart, associate professor English, will be gone winter or spring quarter, 1965 to work on "A Study of American Drama."

Dr. James F. Maclear, professor of history, will be on leave spring quarter, 1965 to study "Popular Interpretations of History and Millennium in Seventeenth-Century England."
