

MINNESOTA LOGGERS' WORKSHOPS TO BE HELD

Area loggers and timber producers will be interested in the Loggers' Workshops which will be held in various locations throughout Northeastern Minnesota this coming week. The main theme of these sessions will be "What's New in Logging." The dates and places of the various meetings are: Monday, November 28, from 7 to 10 p.m., in the Littlefork Elementary School; Tuesday, November 29, from 7 to 10 p.m., in the Old Gym of the High School in Cook; Wednesday, November 30, from 7 to 10 p.m., at the Job Corps Center in Isabella; Thursday, December 1, from 1:30 to 4:30 in the afternoon, at the Forest Research Center in Cloquet; and again that evening from 7 to 10 p.m., at the Ag. Experiment Station in Grand Rapids.

On the program will be Russ Allen, Executive Secretary of the Minnesota Timber Producers Association; James Hensel, Forest Engineer with the American Pulpwood Association; Marv Pearson, Logging Safety Specialist with the Employers Insurance Company of Wausau, Wisconsin; and the District Sales Managers with the McCollough Chain Saw Corporation.

Door prizes will be given at each session and refreshments will be served by the various pulp and paper companies in the area. There will be no fee or charge for the sessions. All timber producers, large or small, are urged to attend. This will be the first of three sessions which are planned to be held this coming logging season.
