# WASHINGTON VS. MINNESOTA

September 24, 1938

In 1936, Minnesota played its first scheduled game with the University of Washington at Seattle before one of the largest crowds ever assembled in the Stadium at Seattle. Minnesota defeated the University of Washington 14-7. The second game of this series with the University of Washington opens the 1938 home football season. Approximately 1,000 alumni from the University of Washington have made the trip to Minneapolis, and nearly another thousand Minnesota alumni now residing in the Western states are seated in the South stands. Minnesota extends a cordial welcome to the Washington team, its alumni, our own alumni from the West and to all of its alumni assembled here today. A special welcome is extended to freshmen.

## NEXT HOME GAME—UNIVERSITY OF NEBRASKA

Saturday, October 1

Tickets will go on public sale Monday morning at the Ticket Office in the Men's Department of Donaldson's in downtown Minneapolis, in the lobby of Cooke Hall on the campus and at Field-Schlick's in St. Paul. About 35,000 seats have been sold in advance for this game. From 45 to 50 thousand persons are expected to see the game. Ticket purchasers who cannot reach any of the Ticket Offices listed above may place their order by remitting by bank draft, postal money order or wire money transfer. Tickets are priced at \$2.75 including tax. Tickets will be sent by special delivery upon receipt of remittance.

## REMAINING HOME GAMES

October 8—Purdue University

Approximately 30,000 tickets have been sold. Tickets are priced at \$2.75. Mail orders close September 26.

October 15—Michigan, Homecoming Game

Tickets are priced at \$2.75. Approximately 40,000 tickets have been sold. You are cautioned to place your order at the earliest possible moment for this game.

November 5—Iowa, Dad's Day

Approximately 30,000 tickets have been sold for this game. Tickets are priced at \$2.75. Mail orders close October 24.

## GAMES AWAY FROM HOME

October 29—Northwestern University at Evanston

Tickets are priced at \$3.00 and mail orders close October 17. Only a few seats remain in the Minnesota section.

November 12—Notre Dame

Tickets are priced at \$3.30. Mail orders close October 31. Only a few tickets remain in the Minnesota section for this game. Please note that this game starts at 1:30 p.m. Central Standard Time.

November 19—Wisconsin at Madison

Tickets are priced at \$2.75. Mail orders close November 7. Only a few tickets are available in the Minnesota section.

## LOST AND FOUND DEPARTMENT

The Ticket Office operates a Lost and Found Department with the aid of the Boy Scouts. Articles found in the stands may be handed to any Boy Scout for delivery to the Lost and Found Department. ## PASS-OUT CHECKS

If it becomes necessary for you to leave the Stadium during progress of the game, and you desire to return, be sure that you leave by the Pass-Out Gates which are numbers 3, 8, 16, 22, 28, and 31. Indicate your intention to return to the gatemen and obtain from them a pass-out check. This check will be required in addition to your ticket stub in order to re-enter the Stadium.
