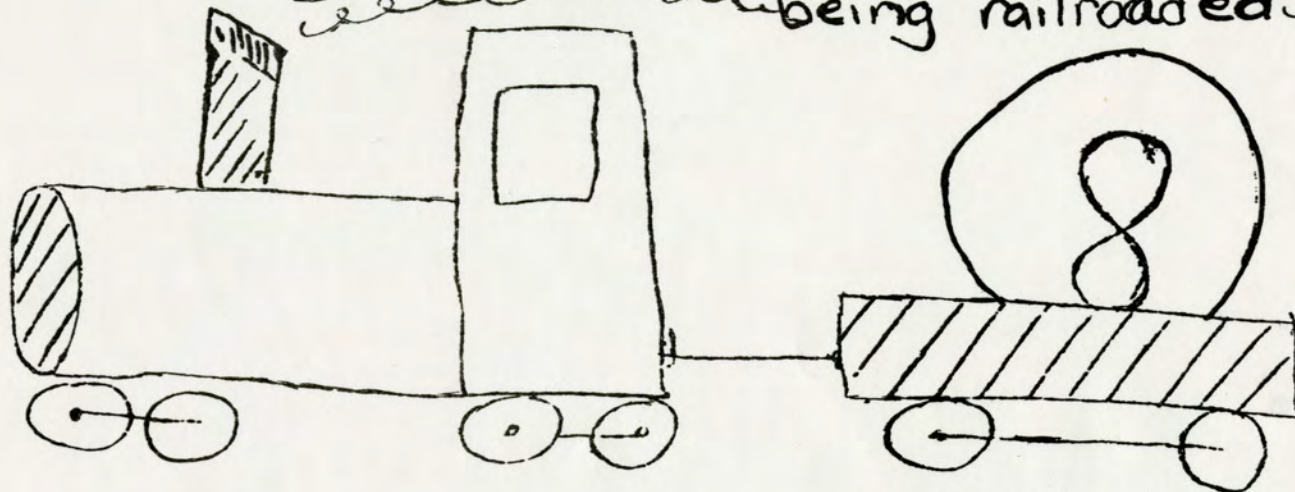

On the night of July 11, 1970, 8 young men acting in the spirit of the Boston Tea Party were arrested inside of 3 out-state draft boards. Initially charged with attempted sabotage of the national defense, the charge has since been changed to interference with the Selective Service System. Judge Devitt will be handling two of two of the three cases, and true to American justice, has been openly conducting unjust and repressive legal action. Allowing insufficient and inadequate time for pretrial motions and forcing the defense lawyer to reveal defense strategy weeks before the trial is due to begin is indicative of the railroading technique being used by Judge Devitt. In order to guarantee that the defendants don't get a fair trial, Judge Devitt has greatly accelerated the "legal" process and has ordered the trials to begin November 2!!!!!! (only 2 weeks).
