Duluth --- Four-hundred-seventy-two undergraduate and eleven graduate degrees will be conferred at UMD commencement exercises at 8:00 p.m. Friday (June 12) in the Physical Education building.

University of Minnesota President O. Meredith Wilson will deliver the commencement address.

UMD Provost Raymond W. Darland will award the undergraduate degrees; Academic Dean Thomas W. Chamberlin will confer the Master of Arts degrees.

Eight ROTC cadets will be sworn in as second lieutenants in the U.S. Air Force Reserve by Capt. Stanley A. Castleman, commandant of cadets at UMD.

The Rev. John W. Hildebrand, Rector of St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Duluth, will give the invocation and benediction.

The University Orchestra, directed by Dr. Robert House, will present a prelude concert "The Overture to Prince Igor" by Borodin; a processional "Huldigungsmarsch" by Grieg; and a recessional "Orb and Septre March" by Walton.

Honored guests at the commencement will be The Honorable Regents William K. Montague and Gerald W. Heaney and former Regent Richard L. Griggs, all of Duluth.

Faculty marshalls will be Dr. Cyril M. Milbrath and Dr. A. Neil Pearson. Admission will be by ticket only until 7:40 p.m., according to Dr. John A. Dettmann, chairman of the commencement committee.
