Gophers vs. Wisconsin & Northwestern



Gophers Conclude First Half of Big Ten Schedule at Home

The No. 21 Minnesota volleyball team concludes the first half of their Big Ten schedule with a pair of home matches. The Golden Gophers (10-6, 4-4 Big Ten) face No. 6 Wisconsin on Friday, then host Northwestern on Saturday.

Wisconsin leads the Big Ten with a perfect 8-0 record in Big Ten play, 14-2 overall. The Badgers defeated Northwestern and Purdue in matches last week. Northwestern (8-7, 4-4) split in action last week, losing to Wisconsin and defeating Purdue.

Minnesota/Wisconsin Match on ESPN2

Minnesota's match against Wisconsin will be televised on a tape-delayed national basis on ESPN2. The broadcast will air on Sunday, Oct. 21 at 2:30 p.m. Handling the play-by-play will be ESPN veteran Chris Marlowe, while former Penn State star Angie Kammer will provide the color commentary.

Hagen Moves into Second on Gopher Blocks List

Senior Stephanie Hagen is firmly implanted in the Gopher record book, and is improving on those marks during the 2001 season. She continues to be the Gophers' career leader with a .356 hitting percentage, is third on Minnesota's all-time list with 449 total blocks, and is now ninth in Minnesota history with 1,190 kills.

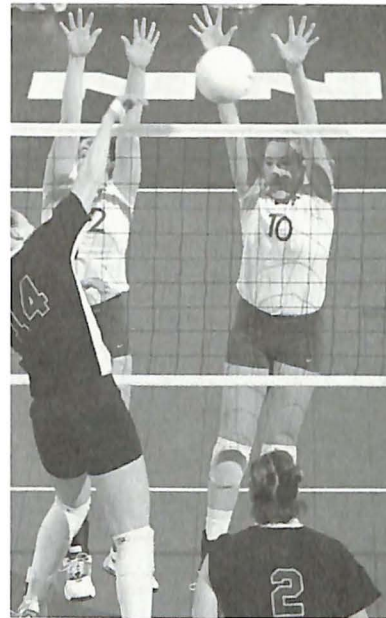
Big Ten Update

Brafford Steps up in Front of Hometown Ohio Fans

Middle blocker Bethany Brafford contributed solid performances over the weekend, especially stepping it up in front of a large group of family and friends versus Ohio State on Sunday. Brafford landed 14 kills in 24 swings with just one error for an impressive .524 attack percentage. The

14 kills matched a career high. On the weekend, she hit .485 to raise her season attack percentage 17 points to a team-high .396.

About Wisconsin

No. 6 Wisconsin, 14-2 overall, is off to its best Big Ten start in Badger history at 8-0. Wisconsin has been dominating the Big Ten, losing over two games in conference play and sweeping its last six opponents. The Badgers are led by a pair of talented seniors in middle blocker Sherisa Livingston and setter Lizzy Fitzgerald. Livingston tops the team in kills with 289, a hefty 5.07 kills per game average. Fitzgerald leads the nation dishing out 14.23 assists per game.

About Northwestern

Northwestern enters the weekend with an 8-7 overall record, 4-4 in Big Ten play. As they complete the first half of the conference season, the

Wildcats have already doubled their Big Ten win total from a year ago. The Wildcats have two of the top blockers in the conference in sophomore Erika Lange, who leads the Big Ten averaging 1.46 blocks per game, and Sarah Ballog, who is third at 1.37

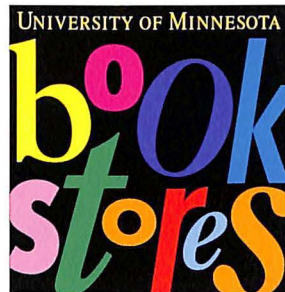

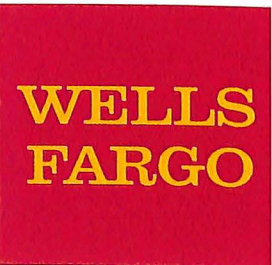
