Duluth-- Final deadlines for applications by graduate students for admission to the UMD summer session have been announced by Academic Dean Thomas W. Chamberlin.

The deadline for the first summer term is May 20 and June 25 is the deadline for the second term, Chamberlin.said.

He also noted that applications by students wishing Graduate School credit in one of the eight special summer workshops must be entered at least four weeks before the beginning of the workshop.

The first summer term at UMD runs from June 17 to July 20, and the second term runs from July 22 to August 24.

Master of Arts programs are currently offered at UMD in the fields of art, curriculum and instruction, education, educational psychology, English, history and educational administration.

Master of Science programs are offered in analytical chemistry, inorganic chemistry, organic chemistry, physical chemistry, physics, biology, botany and zoology.

Additional information on graduate programs or registration may be secured from Dean Chamberlin, UMD, Duluth, Minnesota 55812. A summer session bulletin may be obtained from the Communications Center at UMD.

Dean Chamberlin also noted that the application deadline for admission to Graduate School at UMD for fall quarter is August 23. Fall quarter classes begin on September 23.
