## MASS MEETING

TO PLAN MEMORIAL DAY ANTIWAR ACTION, SUNDAY, MAY 4th

- The Antiwar Movement served notice on the Nixon administration this past Easter Weekend that demonstrations against the Vietnam war will continue until the GIs are brought home alive. 100,000 people demonstrated in New York April 5th; 33,000 in Chicago, and 50,000 in San Francisco on April 6th.
- These actions showed Nixon that he will no longer be able to use the Paris talks as a gimmick to allay antiwar sentiment while he escalates the fighting and bombing in the South. MORE GIs DIED DURING THIS YEAR'S TET OFFENSIVE--THE VIETNAMESE RESPONSE TO NIXON'S ESCALATION--THAN DURING LAST YEAR'S TET OFFENSIVE!!
- This Spring's action also pointed to the growing antiwar sentiment amongst soldiers, their willingness to express it, and their ability to challenge the Army's attempt to deny them their civil rights. 200-300 GIs demonstrated in New York April 5th. Eight soldiers at Ft. Jackson, Columbia, S.C., members of GIs United Against the War in Vietnam, are currently meeting the Army's court martial challenge to their rights by suing in court for their rights to discuss and act legally against the war.
