DULUTH--More than 100 junior and senior high school students from 13 area schools will participate in the second annual UMD String Clinic to be held at Kirby Student Center, Friday, Nov. 3.

The all-day clinic will be directed, again, by Emanuel Wishnow, chairman of the music department at the University of Nebraska. Wishnow is a nationally recognized composer and clinician.

Rehearsals will begin at 9:30 a.m. Friday; a seminar on problems in string techniques and ensemble performance will be held at 1:00 p.m., followed by another rehearsal.

The 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th graders will comprise an "honor" string orchestra which will present a public concert at 7:30 p.m. Friday in Kirby ballroom. It will include selections by the student orchestra plus the first appearance this year of the University String Quartet composed of James Smith, Janet Smith, Robert House and Ralph Anderson.
