DULUTH — Owen Rogers, a junior forward from Frenchmann Butte, Sask., has been reelected captain of the UMD hockey team for the 1965-66 season by his teammates.

Rogers led the Bulldogs to 14 wins, 12 losses and a tie. It was the best record a UMD team has compiled since undertaking a major independent schedule four seasons ago.

Wing Mike Tok of Bovey and defenseman Bob Hill of Duluth were chosen alternate captains. Like Rogers, they will be seniors next season.

Keith "Huffer" Christiansen, the Bulldogs' All-America candidate, was accorded "most valuable player" honors for the second straight year. He is a sophomore.

Christiansen established two new team records with 35 assists and 58 points over the season. Both marks surpassed Harvey Flaman's efforts (32 assists and 56 points).
