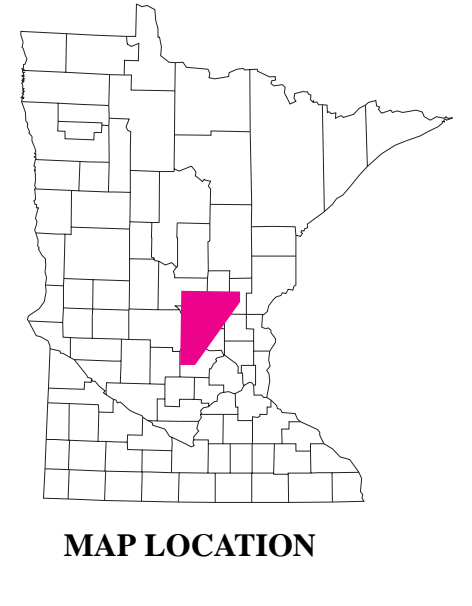
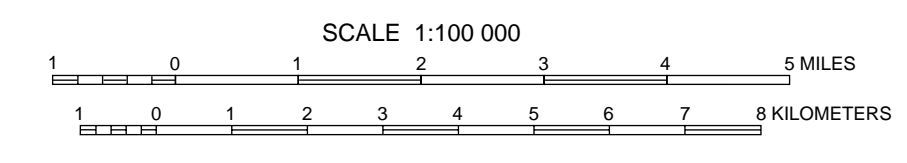


DATABASE MAP OF EAST-CENTRAL, MINNESOTA
