University of Minnesota faculty and other employes at Duluth are among those now eligible for payroll deduction for savings and repayment of loans under the State Capitol Credit Union.

Robert W. Bridges, principal engineer, and Harvard Archerd, senior student personnel worker, said this week details have been completed for UMD personnel to take advantage of the newly authorized service.

Payroll deduction will enable staff members to participate in a convenient method of saving and loan repayments.

The SCCU's university branch was opened in April, 1957. It now has approximately 2,000 members.

Decision to add payroll deduction to the SCCU services available to Duluth and other University employes was made by University administrators headed by President J. L. Merrill.

To participate, the University employe must be an SCCU member.
