## Cleary Named NSIC North Division Player of the Week



**BURNSVILLE, Minn.** – University of Minnesota Crookston men's basketball player Harrison Cleary (Fr., G, Oak Creek, Wis.) was named NSIC Men's Basketball Player of the Week after averaging an NSIC-high 28.5 points per game in contests against Minot State University and University of Mary. Cleary has been named NSIC Player of the Week twice this season, also earning it Nov. 15.

Cleary was 22-of-37 from the field for 59.5 percent on the weekend. He shot 5-of-10 from beyond the arc for 50 percent and 8-of-10 from the charity stripe for 80 percent. Cleary set the school records for points in a season and field goals in a season last weekend, surpassing Joe Hasz's records set during the 2001-02 season. He had a big game in a win over University of Mary as he notched 33 points on 14-of-17 from the field and 3-of-6 from beyond the arc. He also tallied seven assists and four rebounds. Against Minot State, Cleary had 24 points, five rebounds and four assists. He was 8-of-20 from the field and 6-of-6 from the foul line. In addition to his 28.5 point average for the weekend, he averaged 4.5 rebounds and 5.5 assists per game.

The Golden Eagle men's basketball team will open up the NSIC/Sanford Health Tournament on Wed., Feb. 22 as they travel to Upper Iowa University for a 7 p.m. meeting. The winner will advance to the quarterfinals of the NSIC/Sanford Health Tournament, played Sun., Feb. 26 at 2:30 p.m. at the Sanford Pentagon. The winner will face-off against the winner of St. Cloud State University and Wayne State College.
