DULUTH--F. James Glick, assistant professor of chemistry at UMD, will participate in the first institute for college chemistry teachers at Ohio university, Athens, July 13-Aug.22.

He is one of 47 teachers from American universities and colleges attending the institute for teachers of freshman chemistry, sponsored by the National Science foundation.

Institute objective is to bring to chemistry teachers a better understanding of old and new concepts in organic, inorganic and physical chemistry.
