DULUTH -- The annual UMD Recognition Dinner for leadership and service will be held Tuesday (May 3) in Kirby Student Center ballroom with Student Association President Ed Thomas of Duluth as master of ceremonies.

Awards will be presented to the students, the outstanding teacher, student organizations and faculty and staff for contributions during the 1965-66 academic year.

The Student Association Executive Council and the Kirby Student Center Program Board for 1965-66 will be introduced along with the recently elected SA officers for 1966-67.

The top honor for student achievement is the Sieur du Luth Award. A maximum of five can be presented. Up to 15 Bulldog Awards and up to 45 Arrowhead Awards also are available.

The maximum number of Faculty-Staff awards is three. There is one Outstanding Organization award given but as many certificates of merit are awarded as the committee deems appropriate.
