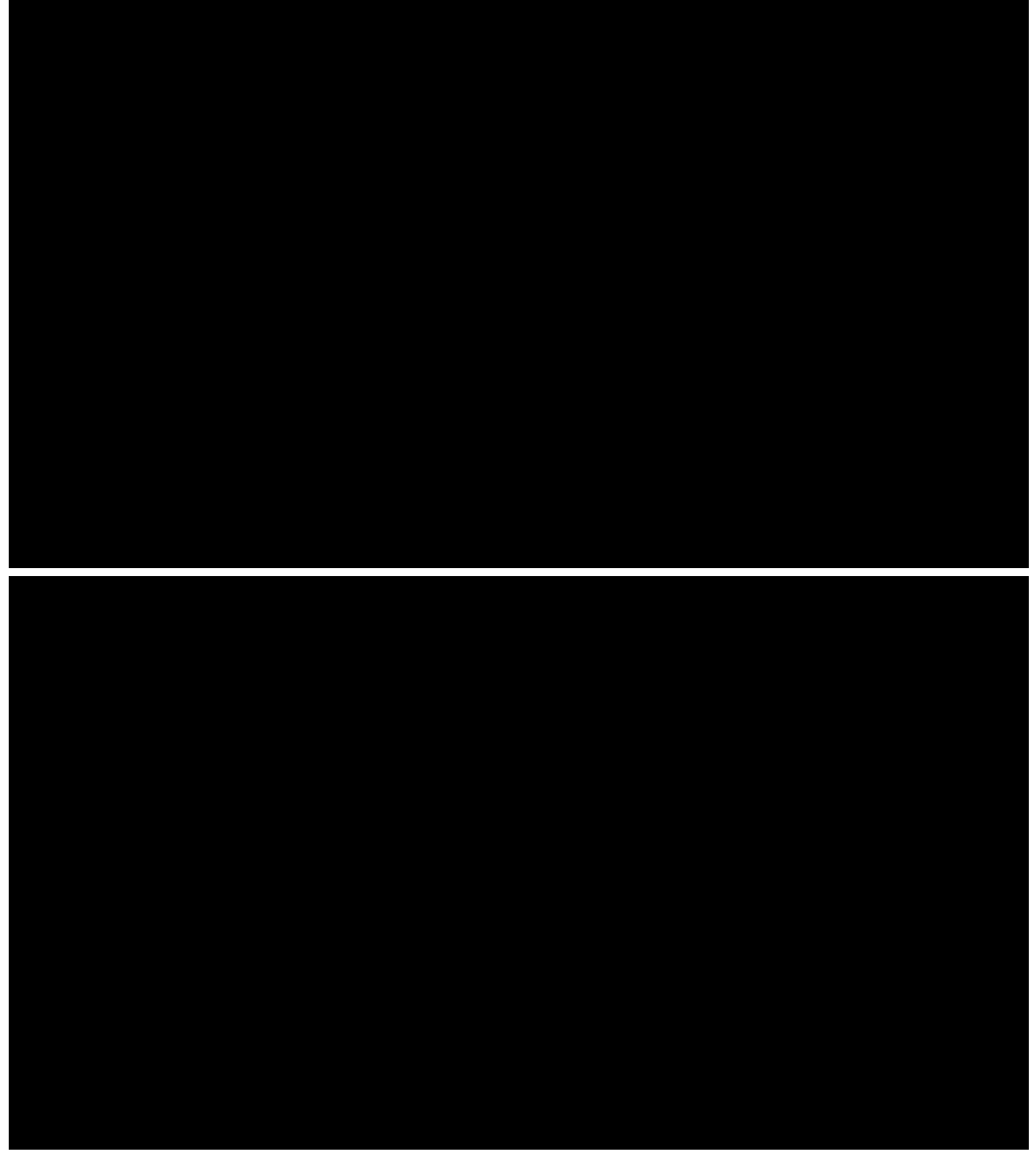

Armorst, McIntyre and Person Named UMC Teambackers Student-Athletes of the Week



CROOKSTON, Minn. - University of Minnesota Crookston soccer players [Delaney McIntyre](#) (Sr., D/MF, Flin Flon, Manitoba) and [Courtney Armorst](#) (Sr., F, West St. Paul, Minn.) and football player [Dre Person](#) (Jr., RB, Detroit, Mich.) were selected as UMC Teambacker Student-Athletes of the Week. The three student-athletes were selected for their on-field performances during the seven-day stretch from Oct. 15-21. All three are first-time honorees for the 2015-16 athletic season.

McIntyre and Armorst were selected for both having major roles in UMC soccer's first-ever six-point weekend on the road in NSIC play. The Golden Eagles are now in ninth place, putting themselves back into the discussion for the NSIC Tournament, which takes the top eight teams.

McIntyre had two goals on the weekend, including scoring the game-winner Sunday over Northern State University with two seconds left in the first overtime. McIntyre also tallied a goal in UMC's come from behind win Saturday over Minnesota State University Moorhead to capture the Highway 75 Rivalry Rock. McIntyre has four goals and three assists as a senior and is second to Armorst for points for the Golden Eagles this season.

Armorst also had two goals for UMC on the weekend. Armorst scored the game-winner with just over four minutes remaining against MSU Moorhead to allow the Golden Eagles to come-from-behind and capture the Highway 75 Rivalry Rock. In addition, she tallied the game-tying goal Sunday against Northern State on a penalty kick. Armorst was named NSIC Offensive Player of the Week for her performance on the weekend. She leads UMC in scoring with five goals on the season.

Person had a breakout game for the UMC football team. The junior running back finished with 18 carries for 178 yards with two touchdowns. He had a 52-yard touchdown run and a six-yard touchdown run in which he dove over two Northern State defenders to score. Person also had a long run of 54 yards to set-up another Golden Eagle score in a 55-21 loss. Person leads the Golden Eagles in rushing this season with 80 carries for 383 yards and two touchdowns.

The UMC Teambackers Student-Athlete of the Week award honors accomplishments of Golden Eagle student-athletes on the field, in the classroom and in the community.
