DULUTH--"Pass By and Laugh," an original play by Alan Caine, director of United Campus Christian Fellowship at UMD, and Derik Shiel, a friend from Dublin, Ireland, will be presented at 8:00 p.m. Sunday at Lakeside Presbyterian Church.

A second performance of the Easter play will be given at 8:00 p.m. on Good Friday at Pilgrim Congregational Church.

Theme of the play, according to Caine, is that "light has come into the world, but men loved darkness more than the light." The play speaks of the humanness of the Biblical greats and ties them to present-day people in character as well as in costume. Through lighting effects, much of the action of the production is in silhouette form.
