DULUTH -- Sculptor Boyd Christenson, an instructor of art at UMD, is one of three Minnesotans exhibiting their creations in "Invitation 67" at Minneapolis' Walker Art Center through April 9.

The other contributors are Minneapolis painter Siah Armajani and another sculptor, Jay Yager of Chaska. The invitational is the fourth in a series featuring resident Minnesota artists.

Christenson is exhibiting six pieces in which he utilizes combinations of bronze, aluminum, corduroy, plaster and wood. One critic found Christenson's use of material "the most interesting of the three (artists)."

Christenson joined the UMD faculty in 1964. His previous shows include one-man exhibitions at the Lafayette (Ind) Art Center, the 11th annual Ball State Teachers College Drawing and Small Sculpture Exhibition (Muncie, Ind.) and the 1966 Biennial of Painting and Sculpture at the Walker Art Center.
