Gophers Begin Six-Match Home Stretch

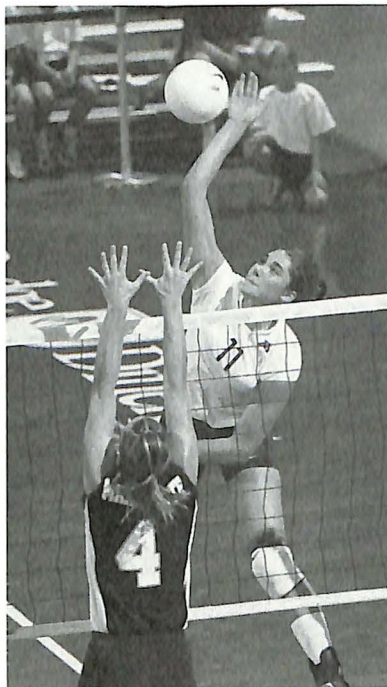
Minnesota gets the chance to enjoy its first extended home-match stretch of the 2001 season. The Golden Gophers (12-8, 6-6 Big Ten) have played just five of their 20 matches on the road but begin a six-match home stretch on Friday, when they play host to Michigan. Minnesota will then play host to Michigan State on Saturday and Wisconsin-Green Bay on Monday. The six-match stretch will take place over just a 10-day period.

Liking the Way the Schedule Shapes Up

Defending your home court is always a key to success in any team's drive for an NCAA bid. The Gophers played their first four Big Ten matches on the road, but now have the benefit of playing six of their remaining eight Big Ten matches at home.

The Heir Apparent Impressive in Big Ten Debut

Lindsey Vander Well was impressive in her first Big Ten start, Saturday versus Indiana, as she replaced the injured Lindsey Berg in the starting lineup and collected 60 assists. Vander Well drew praise from Gopher head coach Mike Hebert, who credited his rookie setter for playing like a veteran and taking control on the court.

The Gophers Hold Block Party at Indiana

Minnesota led the Big Ten and was one of the finest blocking teams in the nation a year ago, but in 2001, the Gophers have not found that much success in that portion of their game. Until Saturday night at Indiana, that is. Against the Hoosiers, the Gophers' block edged on intimidating. The Gophers easily posted their highest team block total of the season in posting a 21-10 advantage in team blocks. Bethany Brafford stuffed 11 Hoosier shots, tying a career high. Two other Gophers contributed over five blocks in the match, with Stephanie Hagen adding seven, and Lindsey Vander Well chipping in a career-high six blocks.

Two Post Double-Doubles Versus Indiana

Perhaps it is the new scoring system this season that has made the double-double a less frequent occurrence in collegiate volleyball. Prior to Saturday's match at Indiana, the prestigious double-double was earned only six times during the 2001 Gopher volleyball season. Against the Hoosiers, it happened twice. Bethany Brafford scored the more rare form of the feat, the kill/block variety, tallying 13 kills and 11 blocks. It was Brafford's first career double-double. Kathy Tilson posted her third double-double of the season, collecting 17 kills and 13 digs.

When She's Hot, She's Hot

When Gopher middle blocker Stephanie Hagen is in a groove, watch out. Hagen, already one of the finest hitters in the Big Ten boasting a .369

attack percentage, fires up to a .478 percentage when the senior pounds home 13 or more kills in a match. Her 17-1-33 for .522 performance in her last outing against Indiana, was her seventh match above 13 kills this season. In her career, Hagen has posted double-digit kills in 56 matches.

Big Ten Update

For the first time in the 2001 season, five Big Ten teams are nationally ranked after Illinois joined the poll at No. 25. Other ranked teams are No. 7 Wisconsin, No. 10 Ohio State, No. 11 Penn State and No. 24 Minnesota. Two winning streaks ended in the last week of Big Ten play. Wisconsin lost its first Big Ten match of the season to Penn State, ending an 11 Big Ten match winning streak. Ohio State was defeated at home by Wisconsin, so now each Big Ten team has lost at least once on their home court.

About Michigan

Michigan is 11-8 overall and one game ahead of the Gophers, at 7-5 and fifth in the Big Ten. Middle blocker Erin Moore leads the Wolverines, averaging 3.32 kills per game and hitting for a .282 attack percentage.

About Michigan State

Michigan State enters the week at 13-6 overall and 6-6 in Big Ten play. The Spartans fell out of the national poll two weeks ago, after receiving votes in each of the first eight polls of the season. Outside hitter Erin Hartley is averaging 3.87 kills per game and hitting .334.

About Wisconsin-Green Bay

Wisconsin-Green Bay is 11-11 entering the week. The Phoenix are led by sophomore middle blocker Janelle Tomlinson, who is averaging nearly four kills a game. Green Bay plays two matches this weekend before facing the Gophers on Monday.

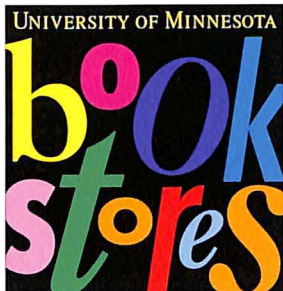
