Golden Eagle Men's Golf Signs Rosemount's Humble



CROOKSTON, Minn. – The University of Minnesota Crookston men's golf team announced the signing of Connor Humble (Rosemount, Minn./Rosemount H.S.) to a National Letter of Intent. Humble is the first signee for Head Coach [Jason Tangquist](#) and the UMC men's golf team. Humble joins his sister Ashlee Humble, who is a member of the UMC women's golf team.

"We are very excited to have Connor join our program for the Fall of 2017," Tangquist said. "Connor has had a successful high school career and we have seen his hard work pay off in the classroom and on the golf course. I am sure he will have a great Spring 2017 high school season. He will play a tournament schedule in the Summer, and will be ready to have an immediate impact on our program upon arrival. He has dedicated himself to getting tournament golf experience and that will benefit him at the college level."

Humble joins a young team that includes 10 student-athletes who are on schedule to return for the 2017-18 season. The Golden Eagles currently have eight golfers that are either freshmen or sophomores.

Connor Humble (Rosemount, Minn./Rosemount H.S.)

Humble was named the Most Valuable Player for Rosemount H.S. He was an All-South Suburban Conference Honorable Mention pick. Humble placed second at the Junior Tour event at Emerald Greens Golf Club in Hastings, Minn. July 22, 2016. He tied for seventh at the Players' Tour Series C5 at the Mankato Golf Club. In 2015, Humble won the Junior Tour at Rich Valley Golf Club in Rosemount, Minn. He tied for first at the Junior Tour event at Emerald Greens Golf Course in Hastings, Minn. He tied for fourth on the Junior Tour at Goodrich Golf Course in St. Paul, Minn.

Humble is the son of Jeff and Anne Humble. He was born Feb. 14, 1999. Humble plans to major in sports and rec management.

All signees are contingent upon admission to UMC and compliance with NCAA rules, including certification by the NCAA Eligibility Center. Everyone released today has signed their National Letter of Intent prior to release of information.
