Duluth--- Twenty lithographs illustrating Japanese poems about the four seasons are on display in the lounge at UMD's Kirby Student Center. The exhibition, by Arthur Flory, will run through December 21.

The exhibition, entitled 'Haiku of the Four Seasons,' has five pictures for each season. A haiku is a Japanese poem composed of 17 syllables, and usually has a seasonal reference.

The lithographs, like the haiku that accompany them, are suggestions of the seasons and leave something for the viewer to think about.

Kirby Student Center will be open from 8 a.m. to midnight through December 15 and from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on December 18 to 22. The exhibit is open to the public.
