Duluth --- A display of 1500 new library books is being shown from 1:00-4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday in the Fine Arts lounge in UMD's Kirby Student Center.

Mrs. Lorraine Bissonett, Laboratory School librarian, said the books cover the reading interests of children from kindergarten through senior high school. Joanne Rudolph, assistant to Mrs. Bissonett, helped prepare the display which will be up through July 2.

The books have been supplied by Books on Exhibit, a national exhibiting operation in the field of young adult's and children's books.

The exhibit makes it possible for teachers and librarians to do a more efficient job of book selection in a minimum amount of time. Included are annotated catalogues with cross-reference, title and author indexes.

In the junior and senior high school categories, the collection covers 863 titles covering some 70 subject classifications. There are 729 new titles in the elementary section.
