

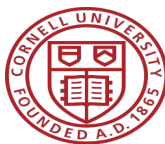

DCN Transitioning to Membership Model

Opportunity for you and your institutions to participate!

Data Curation Network Membership Tiers

Tier 1: Partner	This is the highest level of participation. Partner institutions contribute curator staff to the Network and have full participation in governance.	\$10,000 for all benefits and up to 200 hours of curation	Applications accepted thru March 31, 2021
Tier 2: Member	Members at this tier may choose not to contribute in-kind curator staff, but may participate in other ways.	Rate TBA in Spring 2022	Limited beta testing in 2021. Contact us
Tier 3: Ambassador	Ambassadors invite DCN curators to teach a "Specialized Data Curation Workshop" at their institution.	\$2,500 for one DCN workshop plus instructor travel	More details on our curricula
Tier 4: Sponsor	Repositories, publishers, federal agencies, and other organizations may support DCN.	Example: \$1,000 to sponsor annual All Hands Meeting in July 2021	Contact us with your ideas!

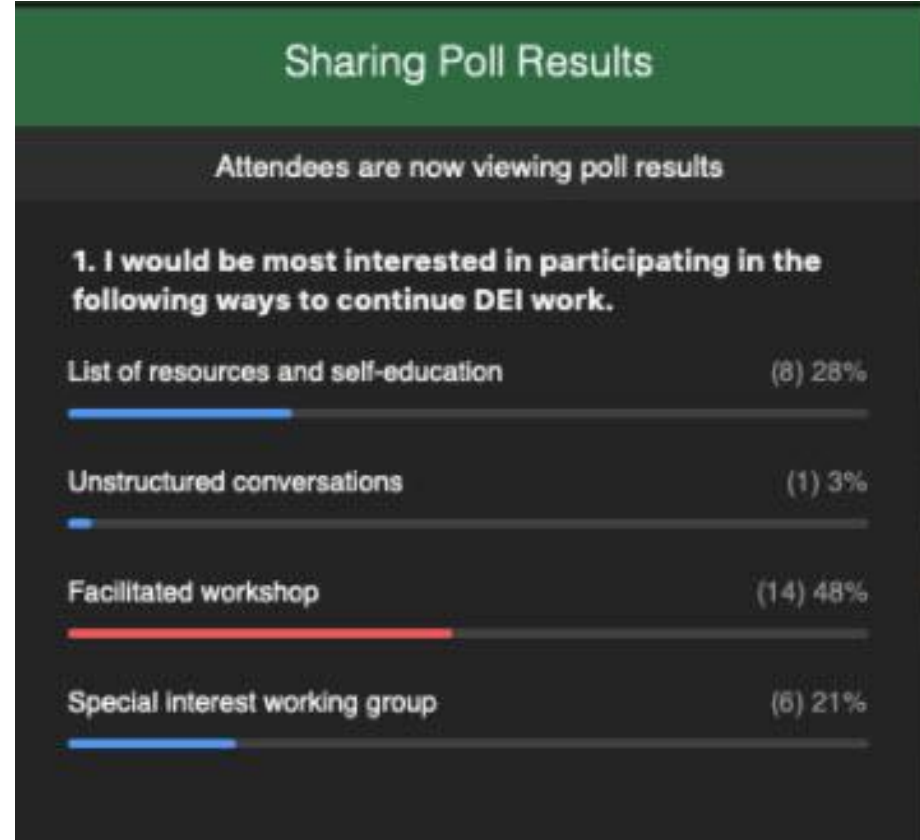
