CAMERAS

Under a ruling of the Big Ten Conference, the taking of still or moving pictures at Conference games is prohibited. Spectators are requested to comply with this regulation and guards and ushers have been instructed to enforce the rule.

LOST AND FOUND DEPARTMENT

The Ticket Office operates a Lost and Found Department with the aid of the Boy Scouts. Articles found in the stands may be handed to any Boy Scout for delivery to the Lost and Found Department. PASS-OUT CHECKS

Indicate your intention to the gatemen and obtain from them a pass-out check. This check will be required in addition to your ticket stub in order to re-enter the Stadium.
