

Duluth--- Homecoming Week at UMD officially begins this Saturday (Oct. 19) when the first of 15 events gets underway. Activities will continue until Homecoming Day on Saturday (Oct. 26).

The Bulldog's homecoming game will be at 2 p.m. (Oct. 26) with the Concordia College Cobbers at Griggs Field.

During the week, approximately 25 student organizations will be competing for all-par points in the athletic events and other competition. All-par winners will be announced at the Homecoming Dance.

Saturday's (Oct. 19) Volkswagen Push calls for seven-man teams (1 driver, 6 pushers). The team must push a stock Volkswagen over a straight course on Oakland Ave. beginning at College St. Races will be run in heats of two cars beginning at 1:30 p.m.

A car rally will be held Sunday beginning at 10 a.m. at the turn-around near the Science and Math building.

The Homecoming Queen will be crowned Sunday evening during intermission at the 8 p.m. Homecoming kickoff concert in Kirby Ballroom. The concert will be given by the '3-D's', Capitol recording artists from Utah.

Contestants for Queen are Gail Schipper, sponsored by the UMD Chronicle; Sharr Rasmussen, sponsored by Sigma Tau; Mary Kay Pedersen, sponsored by the Women's Recreation and Extra-mural Program; Lynn Luukinen, sponsored by the Physical Education Majors and Minors; and Gail Brown, sponsored by Gamma Omicron Beta. All are from Duluth.

On Monday (Oct. 21) a tandem bicycle relay will be held at 10:30 a.m. on the tundra near the Humanities building, and the first of a series of tug o' war contests begins at 3:30 p.m. over the biological pond near Burntside Hall.

Athletic events on Tuesday include a 10:30 a.m. tricycle relay on Ordean Court. Contestants must pedal a small tricycle and hand off corncobs at given relay points.

A paper airplane toss will be held at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday in Kirby Lounge, and tug o' wars commence at 3:30 p.m.

There will be a corn husking and shelling contest at 10:30 a.m. Thursday in Kirby Lounge, and tug o' wars at 3:30 p.m.

A mystery event will be held at 4:30 p.m. Friday on the Kirby Terrace. The contest will be announced at the beginning of the event.

On Homecoming Day (Saturday Oct. 26), campus groups will construct Homecoming displays in the morning for judging before the game. The Bulldog Bean Feed will be held from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. in the Physical Education Building. The dance will be held from 9 p.m. to 1 a.m. in Kirby Student Center.
