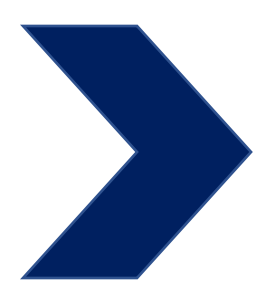


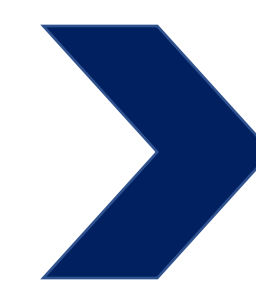

Primer components may include:

- Key questions for the curator
- Key questions for the researcher
- Metadata
- Tools
- Preservation considerations

Check files and read documentation

Understand the data or try to

Request missing information

Augment metadata

Transform for reuse

Evaluate for FAIRness
