

DULUTH--"The Reluctant Americans" will be discussed by Carl T. Rowan, Deputy Assistant Secretary for Public Affairs, at UMD's 14th annual commencement at 8 p.m. Friday (June 9) in the Physical Education building.

Three-hundred and forty-three degrees and six Air Force commissions will be awarded.

Undergraduate degrees will be conferred by Provost Raymond W. Darland, assisted by Robert J. Falk, associate director, Office of Student Personnel Services.

Fourteen Master of Arts degrees will be given on behalf of the University of Minnesota Graduate School by Academic Dean Thomas W. Chamberlin. He will be assisted by Provost Darland and Dr. Valworth R. Plumb, chairman of the Division of Education and Psychology.

Six Air Force commissions will be awarded by Capt. Bernard D. Melvin, assistant professor of ROTC.

Faculty Marshals will be Dr. Gerhard von Glahn and Dr. Emmett Davidson.

The Reverend Father Robert W. Klein, advisor to the Newman Club, will give the invocation and benediction.

The University Band, directed by James Murphy, will open the program with the "Overture to Nabucco" by Verdi. For the processional, as graduates and faculty members enter in cap and gown, the band will play "Pomp and Circumstance" by Elgar. The Air Force ROTC color guard will present the colors.

Congratulations to the class of 1960 will be given by University of Minnesota Regent Richard L. Griggs, Duluth.

Rowan, 35, recently returned to Washington, D.C. after traveling through South and Southeast Asia with Vice President Lyndon Johnson. Rowan left his post with the news staff of the Minneapolis Tribune last February to take over his new duties as a Department of State liaison man with the press, radio and television in the area of foreign policy interpretation.

Rowan has won numerous national awards for his reporting of domestic and international affairs, has written a number of articles for national magazines, and is the author of four books.

Following the commencement address, the awarding of degrees and the benediction, the band will play "London Pageant" by George Melanchnino for the recessional.
