Duluth--- August 1 is the date to remember for students planning to enroll at UMD for the fall quarter, according to Mrs. Marjorie Austin, UMD admissions coordinator.

Mrs. Austin stated that undergraduate degree candidates who plan to attend UMD for the first time must have their applications for admissions filed by August 1. Transfer students must also have official transcripts submitted before this deadline, she added.

August <sup>1 (one)</sup> is also the deadline for students who were on probation when they left UMD to petition the Scholastic Committee for permission to re-enroll.

"A September 15 deadline applies to applicants for Special Student status," Mrs. Austin noted. People who wish admission as Special Students must submit a petition to the Scholastic Committee by the September deadline. She explained that this category includes teachers in-service and other holders of the bachelor's degree who have not been admitted to Graduate School, but would like to take courses to meet special needs.

A \$10 application fee made payable to the University of Minnesota, Duluth, should accompany new applications.

Freshman applicants must complete the American College Test before they can be admitted. Details about the test may be secured by calling the UMD Counseling Office.
