Duluth-- UMD Student Association President Peter M. Ramme, Rochester, will appear on an all-color, television show at 5:30 p.m. Sunday (Mar. 3) honoring the University's 117th birthday.

It is the first time the University's anniversary is being celebrated on an hour-long, state-wide telecast. The show will originate on KTCA, Twin Cities educational station and will be carried by WDSE-TV, Duluth ETV station.

University President Malcolm Moos will head a panel discussion on higher education on the show entitled "Charter Day, 1968."

Film visits to the Crookston, Morris, UMD, and Twin Cities campuses will precede the panel discussion.

Joining Pres. Moos and Ramme on the panel will be Regents Professor of Anthropology, E. Adamson Hoebel; Regents Professor of Physics Alfred O. C. Nier; student Robert R. Verbrugge, president of the Intermediary Board of the College of Liberal Arts; and student William C. Newell, president of the Minnesota Student Association. Moderator will be E. W. Ziebarth, Dean of the College of Liberal Arts.

Producer and master of ceremonies of the hour-long show will be Robert Boyle, program director of KUOM, Minneapolis.
