University of Minnesota Press

Mrs. Margaret S. Harding, Director of the University of Minnesota Press, has reported substantial gains in this department during the 1948-50 biennium. This period, according to Mrs. Harding, showed a 35 per cent increase in sales over the preceding biennium, and 65 books and pamphlets were published in the two year period ending June 30, 1950 as compared with 48 in the preceding biennial period.

A new catalogue of University of Minnesota press publications which are now in print lists 205 titles by a total of 211 different authors. Scope of the publishing program represents a wide range of interests, mirroring the activity of the university as a whole.
