Duluth -- A recital of American songs will be presented by UMD instructor of music Mrs. Lorie Langdon at 8:15 p.m. Tuesday (Jan. 16) in Education 90.

Among the numbers will be several well known poems set to music by American composers. Included will be Robert Frost's "Stopping by Woods on a Snowy Evening" with music by John La Montaine; James Joyce's "I Hear An Army" with music by Samuel Barber, and English poet A. E. Housman's "Loveliest of Trees" with music by John Duke.

Mrs. Langdon also will sing an aria from "The Consul," an opera by Menotti.

Mrs. Langdon's accompanist will be Evan Ferber, a member of the piano faculty at the College of St. Scholastica. He also will play a selection by the American composer Griffes.
