DULUTH--Dr. John B. Carlson, an associate professor of biology at UMD, has been selected to attend the University of Washington's Institute of Radiation and Biology this summer.

Dr. Carlson will join 19 other university people from throughout the country for eight weeks of study in radiation biology from June 18 until August 10.

The Institute, jointly sponsored by the National Science Foundation and the Atomic Energy Commission, spends the first week at the Hanford Atomic Works near Richland, Wash.

Dr. Carlson has been at UMD since 1954. He received his Ph.D. at Iowa State College in 1953 and taught there one year before moving to UMD.

A native of Virginia, Minn., Dr. Carlson is married. He and his wife, Delores, have three sons; Stephen, John and Michael, and one daughter, Janice.
