# Prospects

The Bulldogs with 21 lettermen in tow, have been tabbed among the teams capable of displacing defending champion St. John's.

If the Bulldogs are to return to the glory days of 1960, 1961, it will take a complete reversal of form from last season's 3-4 record. Many observers feel they are capable of doing just that.

An improvement in capable depth but still not enough of it creates the unknown that could upset the predictors. Key injuries could change the picture from good to questionable.

**QUARTERBACK**—In the capable hands of team captain Steve Sands with backup coming from sophomores Lee Christiansen and Scott Gernander. Outlook solid.

**HALFBACKS**—Eric Eversley, a regular in '65 is set, but the other spot is up for grabs. Senior Curtis Johnson, listed as no. 1 in the spring decided to pass up his final year of eligibility moving newcomer Harry Davis into a starting role. A minor injury sidelined Davis and Joel Hall is the current custodian of this spot. Senior Bernie Tanski will probably back up both sides, and if solidification does not occur fullback Gary Egerdahl could find his way into the picture. Outlook questionable.

**FULLBACKS**—The presence of Egerdahl, who led the Bulldogs in rushing last fall, and talented newcomer Dick Voltzke, provide the position with a solid one-two punch. A little more size is the only desire here.

**CENTER**—A strong position with three lettermen back in the fold. Senior Mike Murphy has the inside track on the offensive job with capable backup from Tom Bell III and Kim Burkey.

**TACKLE**—Six lettermen headed by 6-4, 245 pound Vern Emerson return to make this the strongest in-depth position on the team. Emerson will be joined by seniors Jim Martin and Gary Zanko, junior Jerre Broselle and sophomores Neil Ladsten and Don Lacher.

**GUARD**—A problem area with Dave Halverson and Jim Mason the lettermen returnees. Mason, converted to an end position last spring has made the move back, to give the position capable strength. Non-lettering sophomores Glen Kelly and Dave Esser hold the key.

**ENDS**—Putting things together is the problem here. Four seniors Bob Wilkowski, Fred Anderson, Herb Lewis and Don Larson give the position strength, size and experience, but none combine pass catching and blocking abilities in the right combinations. Wilkowski and Anderson are likely to go down in the record books as the most productive pass catchers in UMD football history.

## HEAD COACH JAMES MALOSKY

Came to UMD when Athletic Director Lloyd Peterson gave up football coaching duties ... coached at Edina-Morningside and Morris, Minnesota before coming to Duluth ... prep teams posted a 27-8 record and two championships in four seasons ... his 1957 Edina eleven was rated top prep squad in state ... brought UMD its first Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference title in 1960 ... repeated in 1961 ... in ninth season at UMD ... his Bulldog teams have posted a 40-26-3 record ... Malosky enjoyed all-state honors as high schooler at Crosby-Ironton in 1945 and 1946 in both football and basketball ... held the quarterbacking spot at Minnesota (1946-49) under Bernie Bierman ... earned B.A. and M.A. degrees at Minnesota ... married ... two daughters, Lisa and Linda, and son James Jr.
