Vice Chancellor Bruce Gildseth called the meeting to order. Melanie Lamprecht agreed to serve as chair, and Cindy Hayne had previously agreed to serve as vice chair.

Dr. Gary Sheldon, student conduct code coordinator, attended the meeting to discuss UMD's student conduct code process. Gary passed out the student conduct code. When students have violated any of the 16 offenses outlined on pages 3-5, they are referred to the conduct code coordinator for possible disciplinary action. Also passed out was a handout on the campus student discipline process, the appeal hearing procedures, and the appeals petition form. Students in disagreement with the sanctioning of the conduct code coordinator can appeal to the Student Affairs Committee. A meeting of the Student Affairs Committee would then be called to determine if the appeal request has enough merit to warrant a full hearing. If there is not enough merit, the committee can reject the request. If there is enough merit, a formal hearing would be conducted.

Meetings for the rest of the quarter will be set within one week.

The meeting was adjourned.
