DULUTH--UMD is one of 16 colleges and universities in the nation selected to send a team of four student leaders to participate in a two week laboratory in human relations training at Gould Academy in Bethel, Maine, August 14-26.

The laboratory is the first national leadership training session for college students to be sponsored and conducted by the National Training Laboratories, National Education Association, Washington, D.C.

The laboratory is an extension of the training which NTL has been conducting for executives, educators and community leaders for the past 14 years.
