Duluth -- One-hundred-fifty-five graduate and undergraduate degrees will be conferred at UMD Summer Commencement exercises at 4 p.m. Friday (August 19) in the Physical Education building.

George A. Eddie, superintendent of schools at Hibbing, will deliver the commencement address. He will be introduced by Provost Raymond W. Darland.

Provost Darland will confer the 135 undergraduate degrees after the class has been presented to him by Academic Dean Thomas W. Chamberlin. Dr. Chester W. Wood, director of Student Personnel Services, will present the individual candidates.

Dean Chamberlin will confer the 20 Master's degrees after the candidates are presented to him by Provost Darland.

Fr. Sarantos Serviou, presbyter of the 12 Holy Apostles Greek Orthodox Church, will give the invocation and benediction.

Donald H. Andrews, an instructor in music, will present two organ selections.
