Duluth -- Up to 400 works of art will be featured at the Annual Student Exhibition at UMD's Tweed Gallery beginning with a formal opening at 8:00 p.m. Tuesday (May 25). The show will run through July 5.

All media will be displayed by the more than 100 participating art students--ceramics, sculpture, painting, prints, drawing and jewelry. Most of the creations will be those of art majors, freshmen through seniors.

A faculty jury will select six winners of Alice Tweed Tuohy Purchase Awards---in oils, watercolors, drawings, prints, sculpture and ceramics. The works purchased from the six students are made a part of the permanent student collection of the Department of Art.

A Kirby Student Center Purchase Award by the Fine Arts Committee also will be announced with the work to be hung in the newly established Fine Arts Lounge.

Most of the student works will be available for purchase.

The show is a joint effort by art students and UMD Department of Art faculty.
