WHEREAS, On June 14, 1923 Mr. William Henry Eustis deeded to the University of Minnesota some forty-four (44) acres of land in the City of Minneapolis, being described as

" . . . part of Government Lots Eight (8) and Nine (9) in Section Eight (8), Township Twenty-eight (28), North of Range Twenty-three (23) West of the Fourth Principal Meridian"

to which deed was attached the following memorandum of intended use

"The land hereby conveyed is to be used for the physical, intellectual and moral well being of crippled children. If, however, in the future it shall be found that all of said land is not needed exclusively for such purpose, grantee may use the same for any educational, medical or research purpose that shall not be detrimental to or limit its usefulness for the welfare of crippled children."

WHEREAS, Since the last thirty (30) years, advances have been made in the medical profession in the care and treatment of diseases which formerly resulted in the crippling of children, it appears to be the considered judgment of Dean Diehl, Dr. McQuarrie, and Superintendent Amberg that a rest home is not needed in connection with the current program of the University Hospitals for the medical care and rehabilitation of children.

Be It Resolved, That the proper officers of the University be authorized to consult with the Attorney General with reference to

the possibility of taking court action to relieve the University of the above restriction, for the reason of these changed conditions, in order that the University may be able to sell a part or all of the lands in the forty-four (44) acre site and add the proceeds thereof to the Minnesota Hospital and Home for Crippled Children Fund for the care of crippled children, as was done with moneys received from the sale of the Flour and Corn Exchange and Eustis Building; and to authorize the above officers to bring the necessary court action through the Attorney General or otherwise, as it may seem proper, to serve the best interest of the University.

Voted to authorize the Business Vice President to enter into an agreement with the Twin City Area Educational Television Corporation for rental of transmitter site and studio space involving land and building use charges and building maintenance charges as outlined in letter to Mr. Loring Staples dated December 30, 1955, filed supplement to the minutes, page 9059.

The Business Vice President reported for the information of the Board that Professor Louise A. Stedman, Director, School of Home Economics, had made the University the beneficiary of her University Group Insurance for the use of the School of Home Economics.

President Morrill presented to the Board a letter from Assistant Dean Fenske outlining his meeting with representatives of the Southwestern Minnesota Crop Improvement Association and certain Legislators concerning the establishment of a Southwestern Experiment Station, letter filed supplement to the minutes, page 9060.

For the information of the Regents and the record, the President reported that he had received letters of appreciation from Mr. C. F. Hellstrom, Consul General of Sweden, acknowledging the honorary degree conferred upon him during the fall quarter Commencement Exercises and from Professor John E. Anderson, Institute of Child Welfare, expressing gratitude for the conference and for the dinner held in his honor on the occasion of the thirtieth anniversary of the Institute of Child Welfare and for the scroll from the Board of Regents.

At a meeting of the American Pharmaceutical Manufacturers Association in New York on December 13, 1955, Dr. Charles W. Mayo was honored with the 1955 Scientific and Research Award of the Association and was cited for

his contributions to medicine and to world understanding through his work with the United Nations. On December 14, 1955, the *New York Times* printed an editorial tribute to Dr. Mayo, a copy of which is filed supplement to the minutes, page 9061.
