PURDUE vs. MINNESOTA

October 8, 1938

Today's game with Purdue is the initial game in the campaign for Conference honors. Minnesota plays five of the Conference teams. The remaining Conference games are Michigan and Iowa at home and Northwestern and Wisconsin away. Minnesota does not meet Chicago, Indiana, Illinois or Ohio State this year.

In the nine games with Purdue, Minnesota has won five, lost three and tied one, scoring 126 points to 45 for Purdue. The Purdue Boilermakers from Lafayette, Indiana, have a reputation for hard, fast football, and for brilliant backfield play. Coach Mal Elward's 1938 edition of the Boilermakers will provide a real threat to Minnesota's bid for Conference honors.

NEXT HOME GAME—MICHIGAN, HOMECOMING

Saturday, October 15

About 10,000 seats will go on public sale Monday at the Ticket Office in Cooke Hall, at the Ticket Office in the Men's Department of Donaldson's in downtown, Minneapolis, and at Field-Schlick's in Saint Paul. Out of town purchasers may obtain tickets by remitting by bank draft, postal money order, or wire money transfer. All seats are reserved and all tickets priced at \$2.75, including tax. Approximately 55,000 persons are expected to attend this Homecoming game with Michigan. Attention of all Homecoming fans is called to the return of the balloon tradition which was omitted last year because of the prohibitive cost of helium gas. Girls from the Women's Athletic Association will sell balloons in the runways under the stands prior to the opening of the game to be released at the opening kickoff.

Mail orders for the Iowa Game close October 24, and tickets will go on public sale Monday, October 31.

GAMES AWAY FROM HOME

October 29—Northwestern at Evanston

Tickets are priced at \$3.00 and mail orders close October 17. A very limited number of seats remain in the Minnesota section.

November 12—Notre Dame at Notre Dame

Tickets are priced at \$3.30. Mail orders close October 31. A very limited number of tickets remain in the Minnesota section. Please note that this game starts at 1:30 p.m. Central Standard Time.

November 19—Wisconsin at Madison

Tickets are priced at \$2.75. Mail orders close November 7. A limited number of tickets remain in the Minnesota section.

CAMERAS

Under a ruling of the Big Ten Conference, the taking of still or moving pictures at games is prohibited. Spectators are requested to comply with this regulation and guards and ushers have been instructed to enforce the rule.

LOST AND FOUND DEPARTMENT

The Ticket Office operates a Lost and Found Department with the aid of the Boy Scouts. Articles found in the stands may be handed to any Boy Scout for delivery to the Lost and Found Department. Articles lost in the stands may be traced by calling the Football Ticket Office, Main 8101 or Nestor 1306. Every effort will be made to locate lost articles. Found articles are retained in the Ticket Office only two days. Thereafter, they will be sent to the Lost and Found Department in the Administration Building of the University and should be called for there.

Please retain your ticket stub.

When leaving the Stadium, use the ramp through which you entered.

PASS-OUT CHECKS

If it becomes necessary for you to leave the Stadium during progress of the game, and you desire to return, be sure that you leave by the Pass-Out Gates which are numbers 3, 8, 16, 22, 28, and 31. Indicate your intention to return to the gatemen and obtain from them a pass-out check. This check will be required in addition to your ticket stub in order to re-enter the Stadium.
